As a South African I am very excited that the ISTMA World Conference and General Assembly will be held in South Africa in 2023 and will be hosted by the Production Technologies Association of South Africa (PtSA).

This follows a unanimous decision by ISTMA World to move the 16th ISTMA World Conference, that had originally been scheduled to take place in Shanghai, China in 2023, to Cape Town, South Africa, due to Covid 19 restrictions in China.



The decision was made at the ISTMA General Assembly meeting attend-

ed by 14 ISTMA World member countries in Stuttgart, Germany, during May 2022, and was fully supported by the China Die & Mould Industry Association (CDMIA) which will now host the 17th ISTMA World Conference in Shanghai in June 2026.

This is a win-win solution for ISTMA and both China and South Africa and will mean that the ISTMA World Conference will coincide with the inaugural All Africa Expo, which was planned to take place in 2023.

This 5-day event, collectively branded as All Africa Expo ISTMA 2023, will have four distinct but coordinated elements

- ISTMA 16<sup>th</sup> World Conference with experts from the world's leading tooling companies sharing their experiences and views on sustainable development, technical advances in tooling and skills development.
- African Investment Indaba a platform that will boast Africa's spirit of innovation offering unprecedented insight for investors and global networking opportunities.
- All Africa Exhibition a unique exhibition covers the full spectrum of tooling and manufacturing.
- A comprehensive social calendar for delegates, exhibitors and partners providing a special Cape Town experience

### Destination CAPE TOWN



#### Cape Town International Convention Centre

The event will be held in the Cape Town International Convention Centre (CTICC), opened in 2004, which offers superb facilities and state-ofthe-art technologies, comparable to the best in the world.

The CTICC is located between the city centre and the Victoria and Alfred Waterfront, right in the midst of hotels, restaurants, entertainment, and shopping.

#### Cape Town

Cape Town, South Africa is an ideal congress destination, boasting 6 of the top 10 South African tourist attractions within an hour's drive of Cape Town. These include the worldfamous Table Mountain, Robben Island, the V&A Waterfront, Cape Point, the Cape Winelands and Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens.



Water	Cape Town and the Western Cape's tap water is amongst the best in the world and safe to drink
Climate	The Cape is a year-round destination with warm summers and mild, cool winters. Often described as Mediterranean, with October temperatures ranging from 15°C (59°F) to 27°C (80°F)
Taxes	Value Added tax of 15% is levied on all purchases and services. Foreign visitors can re- claim their Vat on purchased in excess R250 per transaction on departure at the airport
Time	South Africa is GMT + 2. There are no time zone differences in South Africa
Driving	An international driving licence is required when driving in South Africa
Visas	Visas are required from most countries and must be obtained in advance from South African missions abroad. For details visit: <u>www.dha.gov.za</u>
Health Requirements	No vaccinations are required for cholera, smallpox, or malaria. Advisable to check if any other travel restrictions are in force.

#### Passport/Visa

A valid passport is required for entry into South Africa. Please check with your local consulate for specific details of visa requirements from your country.

#### Banks, Currency Exchange and Credit Cards

The currency in South Africa is the South African Rand. Bank hours are normally 9:00 – 15:30 pm Monday to Friday and Saturday mornings 08:00 – 11:00. Visa and Mastercard are the credit cards most used in South Africa. American Express and Diners are not always accepted everywhere.

#### Tipping

10% is standard in bars and restaurants – Note that most restaurants add services at 10% to your bill for tables of 6 or more.

#### Internet Connectivity

The convention centre has wireless internet connectivity, and most hotels offer this in the hotel rooms.

#### Getting Around in Cape Town

The city centre and V & A Waterfront and the area around the convention centre are generally safe, but best not to walk alone, particularly at night.

Private taxis and Uber are readily available and can be booked via the hotel. Minibus taxis and MyCiti bus services are available, but best to seek advice from your hotel concierge.

#### Electricity Power Supply

Electricity is 220 volts. Power sockets are a three, round ring socket type, different to most countries around the world. Many hotels do have two-prong plug sockets. You most likely will need an adapter.

#### Smoking

Smoking is banned in all public buildings in South Africa, including restaurants and bars. The Cape Town International Convention Centre is a non-smoking area.

#### Taxes

State value-added tax is 15% and hotel bed levies 1%. The majority of purchases are subject to a State value-added tax of 15%.

#### Liability

The Organizing Committees and/or Conference Organizers shall not be held liable for personal accidents or losses or damage to private property of registered delegates of the Conference. Delegates should make their own arrangements in respect of personal insurance.

#### Kruger National Park - 3 days, 2 nights

Depart Johannesburg and transfer to Hazyview. Enjoy an "elephant encounter" in the afternoon and dinner at your lodge, Hippo Hollow (on the banks of the Sabie River), where you can often view Hippos grazing on the riverbanks. A full day game viewing will allow you the opportunity to spot the big five and many other animals and birds. This tour can be extended by an extra night or include a stay at a private game reserve.



#### Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe - 3 days, 2 nights

Known by locals as "Mosi-oa-tuya" (the smoke that thunders), Victoria Falls is the biggest falls in the world and is certain to leave you in awe. This tour includes return flights from Johannesburg to Vic Falls, a guided tour to the falls and a sunset cruise on the Zambezi River.

#### Garden Route - 3 days, 2 nights

Enjoy the breath-taking beauty of the Western Cape and the contrast of the semi-desert Klein Karoo. Highlights of this tour will take you in the heart of the ostrich farming industry and cheetah project in Oudtshoorn to the bustling town of Knysna, nestled between the mountainous forest and the ocean. This tour will take you as far as the Tsitsikamma, an area character-ised by large tracts of indigenous forest, beautiful coastline and deep river gorges. This tour can be expended by an extra night.



#### Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe and Chobe - 5 days, 4 nights

Fly from Johannesburg to Vic falls and enjoy a guided tour of the falls (one of the seven wonders of the world), as well as a sunset cruise on the Zambezi River. On day 3 you will be transferred to Chobe National Park – home to Africa's largest concentration of elephants. Game viewing activities include game drives in open vehicles before returning to Johannesburg. Includes: Return airfare ex Johannesburg, 4 breakfasts, full board at Chobe only, accommodation, land transportation, guided tour of Vic Falls, Sunset cruise on Zambezi River, Game viewing activities in Chobe. Excludes: Airport & departure taxes.



#### Etosha Tour Namibia - 4 days, 3 nights

This tour departs from Windhoek or Swakopmund. Travel to Etosha for game drives and an opportunity to explore the various waterholes along the enormous Etosha saltpan. Visit a local handicraft market on return to Windhoek.
